FM System Texture Coat

Description: A high build textured intermediate coat composed of specially formulated acrylic resins combined with multi-directional chopped plastic fiber to provide a tough yet flexible coating.

Use: As a textured intermediate coat for the Life Deck "FM System".

Preparation

Seal all cracks in concrete or magnesite with a Life Deck approved caulk, then smooth the crack with FM #1577 Texture Patching Compound.

Using FM reinforcing tape and FM base coat resin, cover large cracks in concrete or seams in plywood and smooth out with FM #1577 Texture Patching Compound.

Primer Requirements

If the surface is either concrete or magnesite, the surface must be primed using FM #1575 Primer at a coverage rate of 200-300 square feet per gallon.

Important weather guidelines:

1. Apply on warm, clear, sunny days.

2.Do not apply under foggy conditions.

3.Do not apply when rain is forecast within 24 hours.

4.Do not apply if temperatures are expected to drop below 50°F within 24 hours.

Clean-up: Soapy water.

Thinning: Do not thin. (If necessary to maintain workability, thin with a small amount of water.

Texture Coat:

- 1. Protect all surrounding areas with masking paper.
- 2. Mix Life Deck FM #1577 Texture Patching Compound thoroughly.
- 3. Using a roller or an acoustical hopper gun, spray texture at a rate of 80-90 square feet per gallon, depending on desired texture.
- 4. Allow to dry thoroughly before applying top coat. Under normal drying conditions this should be approximately 4 hours.
- 5. Optional Step: A few moments after texture coat application while it is still wet, depending on the temperature, the texture can be "knocked down" using a 20" x 5" pool trowel.
- 6. Scrape and sweep the dried texture surface to remove any sharp or pointed edges.
- 7. Texture may be rolled on with texture loop or carpet roller. Brush all edges with paint brush. Texture may also be troweled although surface may be more slippery without the orange peel finish. In this case, we advise using the safety coating 15 series as a top coat to minimize slipping.
- 8. Apply top coat.
