Read this installation manual completely to ensure proper installation, then file this manual with the owner or maintenance department. Compliance and conformity to local codes and ordinances is the responsibility of the installer.



Separate parts from packaging and make sure all parts are accounted for before discarding any packaging material. If any parts are missing, do not begin installation until you obtain the missing parts.



Lockers should be installed in a climate-controlled environment and shielded from direct sunlight.




Position each locker bench according to your submittal layouts. For bench lockers, determine locker number sequence prior to installation. Make sure all floors and walls are clean and smooth. Remove loose impediments, such as protruding nails, and other debris which could affect installation.



Install only on a level, secure floor surface. Do not attempt to mount on wall or other vertical surface. The lockers must be square AND level AND floor-supported or they will not operate properly. A locker that is square may not be level so be sure to check both. Use shims as required. Carefully lift lockers at the base when moving and positioning. Do not drag the lockers!

- Power Drill
- Pop rivet gun (for number plate installation on locker bench only)
- 9/32" drill bit, 3/16" masonry drill bit and Phillips driver bit

Installation Instructions



Fasten Locker Bench snugly to level, secure floor surface using hardware (provided) as shown.




Using a pop-rivet gun, attach number plates in desired sequence.
