## **USE SUMMARY**

#### COOL SEASON TURF

Kentucky bluegrass, annual bluegrass, rough bluegrass, annual ryegrass, perennial ryegrass, tall fescue, and fine fescues

Use rate: 7 - 8 pts/A

Use reduced rates if grass is stressed from heat or drought. Only apply to fine fescue when it is part of a blend.

#### WARM SEASON TURF

Hybrid Bermudagrass, common Bermudagrass and zoysiagrass

Use rate: 5 - 7 pts/A

Yellowing may occur on Bermudagrass, this can be reduced by the addition of chelated iron or sprayable soluble nitrogen.

#### BENTGRASS

Creeping bentgrass

Use rate: 3 - 5 pts/A

Applications to established creeping bentgrass must be applied in 2 to 3 split applications at 3 - 5 pts/A

#### Wild Violet Control Trial
