DESCRIPTION

CERTI -VEX COATING REPAIR will effectively re-cast an existing coating correcting application imperfections, such as bubbles and over applied thick coatings as well as aid in re-sealing existing concrete surfaces. Its controlled evaporation rate allows the coating to properly dry. Once corrected, the coated floor will have a uniform appearance.

BENEFITS

- Slower evaporation rate than Xylene or Toluene
- Enhances uniform film formation
- Can be used on solvent and waterbased coatings
- Slower evaporation rate helps keep film open to minimize air bubble formation
- Reduces cob webbing
- Non-Red Label

APPLICATION - CORRECT

- Apply with an **Evenflow Applicator** or ¼ "nap mohair roller.
- Use a roller pan to remove excess Coating Repair material from the roller.
- Do not dip and roll or pour and spread.
- Apply a thin amount to the affected area in a lapping motion to re-dissolve the surface film of the coating; it will re-dissolve the coating, blending air bubbles and film imperfections.
- Heavy applications of sealer may require another treatment. Leave dry overnight with good ventilation before using floor.

APPLICATION - RE-SEAL

- Certi-Vex Coating Repair should completely wet the area, but not heavy enough to create puddles.
- Allow surface to dry to tack free.
- Apply Vexcon Certi-Vex Re-Seal It. For more information see product data sheet.

SPECIAL NOTES

- May affect some surface areas if splashed.
- If coating needs to be removed use **Certi - Vex Floor Coating Remover**.
